St Tanwg's Church, Llandanwg, also known as "the church in the sand", is an early medieval church dedicated to St Tanwg in the village of Llandanwg, Gwynedd, Wales.

The current building is medieval, with the western end possibly dating back to the 13th century. However, the presence of 6th century inscribed stones, and the dedication to St Tanwg, suggest much earlier use of the site as a church, possibly dating to around 453 AD as part of St Patrick's work to establish links between Ireland and Britain.

On Wednesday 25th July the Rev'd Shane Griffiths who had commissioned a replica statue of St Piran in resin to commemorate the erection of the Granite statue in the valley of the saints in Brittany brought it to the Church. Luckily the Church was open and these photos were taken.
